



Trap. Neuter. Return.

Douglas County Animal Services is now offering a Community Cat Program, which helps protect the feral cats in our County. Citizens (caretakers) of these cat colonies are responsible for the basic care of these animals. Our Caretakers will then work together to humanely trap the cats, bring them to our facility on designated TNR surgery days, and pick them up the following day to release them back to their 'colony'.

All cats in this program will be examined by a licensed veterinarian, spayed/neutered, Rabies and FVRCCP vaccinated, and ear tipped.



- Douglas County Residents Only—cats must be found in Douglas County
- All cats MUST be in humane traps
- NO CARRIERS, CRATES, or BOXES
- Domesticated cats will be turned away
- No fee necessary
